The Glenwood Public Library Board of Trustees meeting was called to order by President Wilson at 5:32 PM. Present and attending in person were Rachel Rodenburg, Stephanie Colpitts, Joe George and Autumn Yosten. Debra Hines was present via telephone.

### Director's Report:

- New part time hire is Adrianna La Kam. She is interested in staying on in the fall but her schedule at school may present conflicts.
- Michelle is out of town for 3 weeks so the library may be short-staffed during that time. Wilson offered to come in and help out where needed.

- Yosten said that the cemetery told her they do not have the time nor the staff to assist the library with greenkeeping. Buthe applied the first treatment on 5/15 and she will proceed with paying for the annual contract.
- Yosten reported that patron Heidi Klockner mulched the south flower beds and provided mulch for the east bed which Lori and Trent McGolfdrick plan to mulch.
- Yosten is going to look into Blu Track for the library.
- Wilson proposed the coupon for adult summer reading to be issued as a \$5 off coupon at the Friends book sale
- Youth summer reading is starting up and the library is using funding from different sources to cover prizes, supplies and programs: grant donations, amazon wish list donations, Friends.

- Yosten attended the farmers market on behalf of the library and her and the staff will plan on attend alternating weeks from June – August.
